Your Board

Mother Nature is still in that snowy mood, so...

- ❄ **If you are going away for more than 3 days or during a predicted snow event** and are parking next to buildings 3, 4, 5 or 6 (that's the Fox Hollow and Eagle Rock sides), you **MUST** leave your key with a Board member in case it needs to be moved. Cars in those roadways make it more difficult for our snow removal team.
- ❄ **If you have one car and your unit faces North**, we know that it takes longer for the snow and ice to melt. **DO NOT** move your car into a VISITOR spot so the Sun can melt the snow and ice away. First, it doesn't work that fast and second, you are taking away a spot that would go to someone who legitimately needs to use it.
- ❄ **DO NOT use a neighbor's spot** if they are away, or the unit is vacant, **UNLESS** you have made a prior arrangement with them and have told the Parking Commissioner about it.
- ❄ **WHERE DID YOU PARK?** Please ask your visitors where they parked.
- ❄ **If you need your car cleaned off after a snow event**, John at “3 Sons” will do that for \$20 cash. Call him at 516-238-2115. Give him your unit number and phone number. You **MUST** call him first.
- ❄ **Also, DO NOT ask any member of the snow removal crew** to do any additional work. Please allow them to do their job.
- ❄ **For ANYTHING Parking related**, please call the Parking Commissioner.

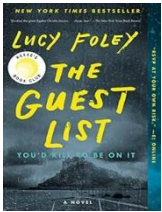
