IMPORTANT THINGS TO NOTE FOR 2026

- ❄ **ALL residents** will be getting messages from our Call-em-All system. It is **IMPORTANT** that you receive these messages, as this is our primary way of communicating with you, especially during any emergency.
- ❄ **If you have bulk items** for garbage pickup (furniture, mattresses, chairs and other large items), please call Jamaica Ash **FIRST** to schedule a pick up. Their phone number is in our Directory. There is **NO CHARGE** for this service. Once you do that, then place your items on the **SIDES** of the dumpsters, never in front.
- ❄ **During a declared snow “event”**, you **MUST** move your car if you’re in a designed **SNOW** spot. Place it in a vacant **VISITOR** spot or on either side of buildings 5 and 6. If you don’t, or your visitors don’t, **YOU** are subject to a fine and it will take that much longer to clear out our development. Please don’t be that person.
- ❄ **Remember that the refrigerator** in the Clubhouse kitchen is for Entertainment Committee use **ONLY!** Anything else in the refrigerator will be removed and discarded.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO NOTE FOR 2026

- ❄ **WHERE DID YOU PARK?** Too often, our visitors park in any open spot they find, often in someone else's assigned spot. We have numerous VISITOR or SNOW spots (except during snow events) that are available for their use, as are the roads next to buildings 5 and 6 and across from building 13. When you have visitors, please make sure they park in one of the designated spots.
- ❄ **PLEASE TURN OFF THE LIGHTS IN THE CLUBHOUSE!** When you are done in the clubhouse, the bathrooms and pool house, please do this one little courtesy item. You wouldn't leave the lights on in your apartment, so please don't do that in the Clubhouse. Remember, the money that pays for the electricity in the clubhouse, and all around our development, comes out of your maintenance every month. Meaning, **YOU ARE PAYING FOR IT!** So, let's be mindful of this and keep costs down for everyone.
- ❄ **During this Winter season,** it is very important to make sure to check on your neighbors, especially those not able to get out easily for shopping and doctor's appointments, for example. Let's watch out for each other. We're all worth it!

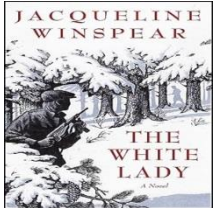
